UDL is an **evidenced-based** educational framework that offers variability in how students access, engage with, and demonstrate their learning. It supports teachers in identifying barriers to learning and designing lessons to increase student engagement and learning.



- Stimulates motivation & sustains enthusiasm for learning by promoting various ways of engaging with the material.
- Presents information & content in a variety of ways to support understanding by students with different learning styles/abilities.
- Offers options for students to demonstrate their learning in various ways.
